

Why Counselling?

Counselling gives individuals an opportunity to explore and clarify ways of living more resourcefully and with a greater sense of wellbeing.

Counselling is available on an individual basis to all service users. It is provided in a variety of settings. (Clinics, Young Persons Programme, Satellites, Health Centres, Community Projects and Cuan Dara).

We Provide

- Assessment.
- Exploration of treatment options.
- · Individual counselling.
- Group work / therapy (in some locations).
- · Educational programmes
- Assessment and referral to other services if required.
- Aftercare.
- Information and support to families and concerned persons where appropriate.
- Support for ongoing recovery.

Confidentiality

Confidentiality is discussed at the first session. Counsellors may have to operate outside the boundaries of confidentiality in the following circumstances.

- Welfare of a child as per "Children First" document.
- Serious risk of suicide or self-harm.
- Serious risk of harm to others.
- When directed by a court of law under a summons or subpoena.
- When the service user is a minor.
